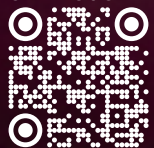

Our wines have been introduced to over **50 countries** in Asia, America, Europe and Africa with over **6 000 000 bottles** sold last year.

Through our long experience, we have developed a deep knowledge of the international wine markets and are able to **select** the most adequate wines **to every demand**.

Our main strength is the flexibility to adapt our offer to the specific wine demands of every market. We are **specialized** in **entry level and medium priced wines**.

Established **since 1870**, our wineries have a **long tradition of making wines**. Today, our facilities and processes are adapted to the new quality standards. Moreover, we have introduced a quality system, with traceability procedure in order to guarantee the highest degree of quality from the grapevine to the final consumer.

Our grapes grow in the **wine area of Southeast and Central Spain**. This area is marked by its Mediterranean climate and its average altitude of 500 metres above sea level.

The **soils** are mainly **calcisols**: they are rich in limestone and poor in organic material.

The **low rainfall, extreme temperatures** in winter and summer and the **long hours under the sunshine**, make possible an exceptional ripening.



DESIGNATION OF ORIGIN JUMILLA

The Designation of Origin (DO) Jumilla is located in Southeastern Spain. It covers a wide area in the northern Murcia region and part of the southeastern Albacete province. The vineyard is located at an altitude of 400 to 800 meters.

What makes Jumilla wines different from others in personality and others is the so-called “**terruño**”, a unique combination of grape variety, soil composition, orientation and vine pruning, as well as climate.

Soil

Soils in this Designation of Origin are brown, calcareous and brown calcareous. Overall, they retain a good deal of moisture and have an average permeability, which allows vines to survive to prolonged droughts, making good use of the water available.

Weather conditions in the area

Sunny and arid, with approximately 3000 hours of sunlight per year.

With scarce and irregular rainfall and, sometimes, torrential downpours.

The average annual temperature is around 16°C, with cold winters reaching sub-zero temperatures, and warm summers with temperatures rising over 40°C.

Vineyards

To talk about the Designation of Origin (DO) Jumilla is to talk about the **Monastrell variety**, the best-adapted to the climate and soil conditions within this designation. It imparts its personality to the wines, which represent more than 80% of the DO's production.

Monastrell bunches are small and compact, with medium-sized, spherical, blue-black berries whose skin is thick and rich in anthocyanins. Its fleshy pulp is soft and low in tannins.

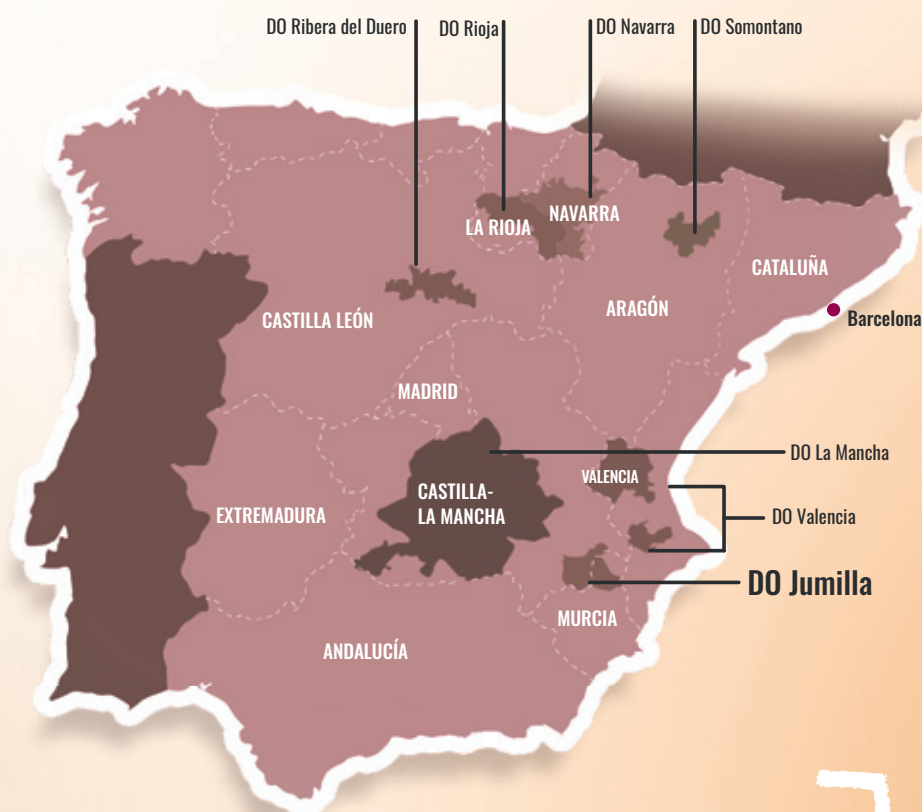

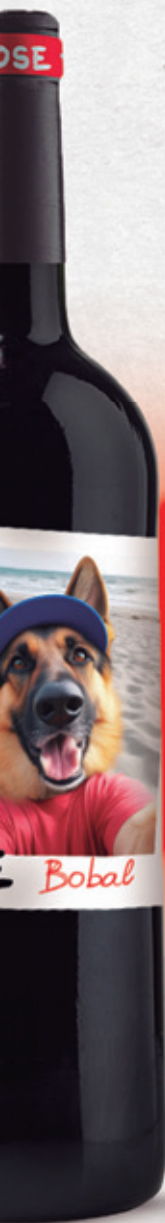

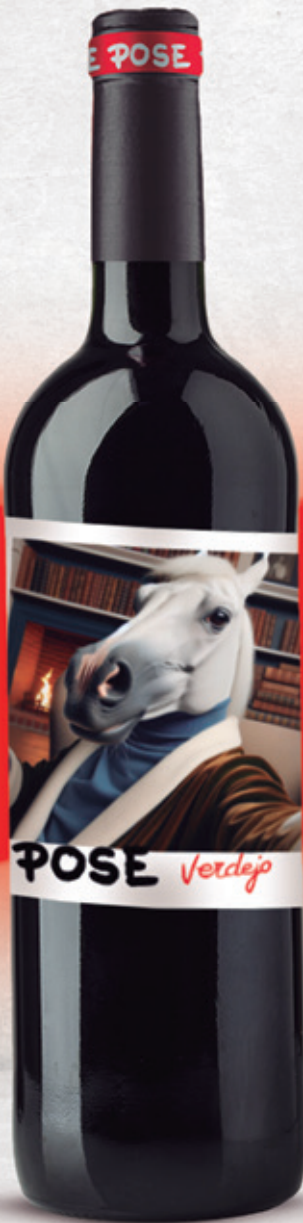

MOSCATO



Moscato wines are those that have been made using the **moscato** grape variety that is famous for its **sweet taste**.

The name moscato is **originated in Italy**, but this grape is one of the **most cultivated** today and one of the oldest and most traditional in **warm and sunny places like Spain** where it is one of the first grapes to be harvested to be the one that matures before.

VARIETAL WINE

Red wines

Cabernet Sauvignon yields low quantities of full-bodied, high-acid and tannic wines that respond well to oak aging and gain complexity in the bottle.

Merlot produces smooth, velvety, aromatic and dense wines. They have an intense ruby color and moderate alcohol content.

Monastrell is typical of Murcia and southern Valencia. This grape produces powerful wines with a solid structure and slightly above-average strength.

Bobal is a native grape of the Valencia region. This variety produces large berries and is known for its intense cherry color with aromas of spices and red fruits.

Syrah displays a vivid to deep violet hue. On the palate, it is robust and structured, with aromas of violets, pepper, berries and aromatic herbs.

Tempranillo is considered Spain's most noble grape and it is widely planted throughout the country. It ages well and produces fruity, high-quality wines balanced in sugar, color and acidity.

Garnacha is native to Spain and is one of the most widely cultivated varieties in the world. It is known for its high alcohol content, low acidity and full-bodied, fruity wines with raspberry aromas.

White wines

Airén is the most widely planted native white grape in Spain, covering around 30 % of the country's vineyards. Its neutral profile makes it ideal for producing simple, refreshing, fruity and crisp white wines meant for early consumption.

Chardonnay produces fresh, elegant and well-balanced wines with a pale golden color and moderate to high acidity.

Verdejo yields crisp, aromatic and lively wines. They display a straw-yellow hue with greenish reflections and vibrant acidity.

Sauvignon Blanc typically exhibits herbaceous character, often reminiscent of bell pepper or freshly cut grass.

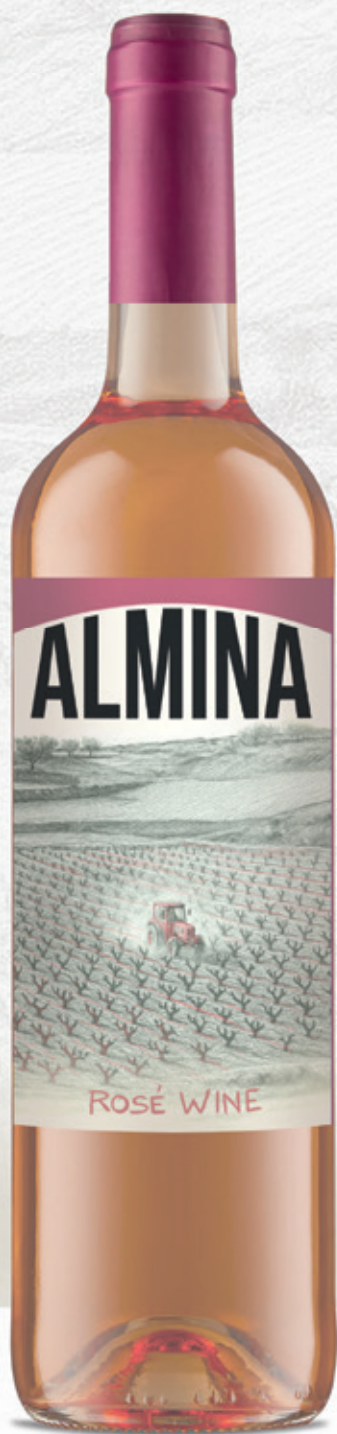
